THE PURPOSE OF THE SUBJECT, LEARNING OUTCOMES:

The students will be able to find a good topic for a podcast, plan the process and put together the first episode

SUMMARY OF THE CONTENT OF THE SUBJECT

Based on their special interest the students decide on the topic of their podcast, and they plan the first episode in detail. They make research in the given field, find their interviewees, elaborate the questions and make the interviews. In the second half of the semester editing is done, and with the narration added the first episode of their podcast is ready

STUDENT'S TASKS AND PLANNED LEARNING ACTIVITIES:

After getting to know different types of podcasts students decide which type suits them the best. They have to write a "scenario" for the first episode based on research made in the field. According to the scenario they select interviewees and prepare for the interviews. When all the recordings are made the final written draft of the first episode is finished, and the editing part starts. In the last phase students have to write and record the narration, and the episode is ready.

EVALUATION OF THE SUBJECT:

Evaluation is based on student's activity in class (50 %) and the final version of the first episode of the podcast (50%)

Student's activity during classes - participation in the formal and non-formal debates and giving new ideas and feedback to other students,

The first episode of the podcast: the ability to advance in journalistic skills, creativity in putting together the different recorded parts of the podcast
