## THE PURPOSE OF THE SUBJECT, LEARNING OUTCOMES:

The students will be able to analyze and discuss social issues, formulate arguments and put together complex journalistic pieces dealing with those issues

### SUMMARY OF THE CONTENT OF THE SUBJECT

Students get to know

- how to ask relevant questions from relevant people in order to get important information
- how to approach problematic issues from different angles
- how to build up a story professionally, put together all the materials in the right order

### STUDENT'S TASKS AND PLANNED LEARNING ACTIVITIES:

Students - after discussing the different tricks of getting "closer" to the interviewee - have to make short interviews in the group ( with the help of "replays" they can experience the result of different approaches)

Students participate in debates - they have to suggest relevant topics and be able to form arguments

### **EVALUATION OF THE SUBJECT:**

Evaluation is based on student's activity in class ( 50 % ) and the two assignments Student's activity during classes - participation in the debates and giving feedback to other students, being able to cooperate with others in the group

Two assignments: the ability to advance in journalistic skills, orthography, in building structures for complex stories and meeting deadlines
