# THE PURPOSE OF THE SUBJECT, LEARNING OUTCOMES:

The objective of this course is to introduce students to the basic element of journalism: news writing, editing and reporting. It focuses on issues like the definition of news, sources of the news, how to handle these sources, news-values, unbiased reporting.

## SUMMARY OF THE CONTENT OF THE SUBJECT

The aim of this course is to equip students with the necessary knowledge about the system of media genres, and especially news. Throughout this course, students will develop their knowledge about the components of news-making, different kinds of news, about the role of news in marketplace and news sources. They also learn about the basic tendencies of the political culture of news; they gather personal experiences about the role of news in different media outlets, and last but least they are walked through the process of writing news about different topics in different media.

### STUDENT'S TASKS AND PLANNED LEARNING ACTIVITIES:

In-class presentations: each student will make two presentations (Power Point, video etc.) at least once during the semester

News stories (500 – 1500 characters), 5 pieces

Final essay: The story of a news story (4000-5000 characters)

#### **EVALUATION OF THE SUBJECT:**

Write at least 4 original news stories.

The best original news story of the week is selected by the group.
